

## Botox Norfolk

Botox Norfolk - Skin wrinkles are by definition a crease, fold or ridge in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin often appear as a result of aging, including: the prolonged immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is a result of habitual facial expressions, sun damage, aging, smoking, poor hydration and various other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water due to prolonged water exposure that causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water within the body as with dehydration likewise can lead to the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is another element that leads to degradation of skin collagen.

Dermal fillers are frequently used to remedy wrinkles and other skin depressions. They are injectable products that are often a type of soft tissue. Dermal fillers are meant to enable injection into the skin for purposes of improving the skins' appearance. The most well-known products are based on hyaluronic acid.

### Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most popular kind of botulinum toxin is referred to as onabotulinumtoxinA or "Botox". This particular kind of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic usage. Botox is used in the treatment of migraine headache and spasmodic dystonia or spasmodic torticollis that is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the head and neck. Botox has many uses together with its cosmetic application.

During 2009, American people now had a new accessible kind of botulinum toxin. This new kind, made by Ipsen, is known as abotulinumtoxinA or Dysport. It has received approval by the FDA and is now utilized to treat glabellar lines in grown-ups and cervical dystonia. Dysport and Botox however, are not the same because the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin efficiently remedies wrinkles by relaxing the muscles that lead to wrinkles. It is indicated for the remedy of glabellar lines, those which take place between the eyebrows in adults and is not appropriate for the remedy of all wrinkles. Whatever other use of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not FDA approved.
